As part of the Sheringham 1940s Weekend, the Bittern Line Community Rail Partnership has teamed up with Sheringham Museum to offer free admission on **Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> and Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> September**. Open from 10.30am to 4.30pm just show a valid rail ticket from anywhere on the National Rail Network to Sheringham where you have arrived in the town between Saturday 14th and Sunday 22nd September to qualify.

Sheringham, on the beautiful North Norfolk Deep History Coast, dates back over a thousand years. The Museum tells the story of the town and its proud, brave, independent people, told through beautiful displays packed with interesting things to see, hear and do.

Running over three floors, the collection includes a rich variety of social history items, agricultural and fishing artefacts as well as a spectacular fleet of boats. There is also a large collection of fishermen's ganseys, those beautifully knitted pullovers that stood as the icon of the coastal fishing industry. The museum has collections of important photographs, fossils ranging from tiny ammonites to bones from a prehistoric elephant, artefacts from both World Wars, an excellent art collection and more.

Many visitors are surprised by the size of the Museum – it's bigger than it appears from outside. You can easily spend an hour and a half exploring just some of its quirky corners.
